

What You Need To Know About FREE FamilyWize Prescription Drug Discount Cards

- For people with no insurance, and for all prescription drugs not covered by insurance, Medicaid or Medicare.
- All cards are bilingual in English and Spanish.
- Accepted at most pharmacies nationwide—including all major chains.
- No age, income or residency restrictions. Anyone can use it.
- No registration, activation or enrollment. No personal information is collected.
- Average discount = 35% or \$20.15 per prescription.

About the FamilyWize card:

40% of people in the United States have either skipped filling a prescription or reduced or skipped doses because they couldn't afford their medicine. More than 835 United Ways in all 50 states have partnered with FamilyWize to organize and coordinate community-wide distribution of these FREE Prescription Drug Discount cards. The nationwide goal is to reduce the cost of medicine for people in need by at least \$100,000,000 over the next five years.

The savings on the cost of the medicine is provided by the more than 53,000 participating local pharmacies that have agreed voluntarily to accept prices for medications that are close to the prices they make available to large insurance companies and employers. All other program costs, including materials, printing, shipping, programming, distribution, reporting, administration, network pharmacy services and customer service are provided by in-kind donations from the program sponsors and by part of the processing fee included in the cost of the medicine.
